FATAL ACCIDENT ON THE RAILWAY. — On Thursday, Mr. G. F. Harrison, coroner, held an inquest at the Red Lion Inn, into the circumstances attending the death of George Looms, a labourer, of this village, aged 80. On Tuesday morning, the deceased left his work to go home. Taking the nearest route he walked along the railway, and was knocked down and killed by a passenger train which was proceeding from Rugby to Market Harborough, when near a crossing between Welford and Theddingworth stations. As soon as the driver saw him on the line, he blew the whistle, but the accident happened before the train could be pulled up. Mr. Shuckburgh Shackelford believed that death resulted from the injuries he sustained, and the jury returned a verdict to that effect.
